Policy for postponement or cancellation

If the tour is canceled by choice of the director. All non-refundable payments will be returned.

If the tour is postponed due to situations outside our control, monies will be held until the time the tour is undertaken or canceled. (see above)

If a student does not travel with the group because of unforeseen circumstances. Monies will NOT be refunded because they will have already been spent

The total price can go down, but will not go up.

Contract and downpayment

This contract is a written commitment that a member or members of your family will be attending this trip. This contract **MUST BE RETURNED BY FRIDAY JANUARY 20 . A non-refundable payment of \$100 must accompany this contract.** If your student has already deposited money into their travel account, this payment is not necessary. If the contract and payment are not received before Friday, the student will not be added into the total count.

Agreement

By signing this contract, the student and their family/guardians, agree to accompany the band on their tour to Southern California. The student and their family/guardians, agree to do all they can, to pay the designated cost of the trip before entering the bus on March 25, 2023. The student agrees to follow all school rules and policies while on tour; knowing that the breaking of rules can result in various levels of discipline, from a stern lecture, to going home early, depending on the severity of the infraction.

MHS School Event/Activity Student Agreement Code of Conduct

Student Agreement

Students must agree to abide by the Standards of Student Conduct outlined in the Students Rights and Responsibilities Handbook. These include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Students understand they are a representative of our community and our school and will conduct themselves appropriately.
2. Students understand they are responsible to contribute to a positive educational climate, to actively participate in the activities, to use considerate behavior, and to protect their own rights and those of other people.
3. Students shall comply with school rules and submit to the authority of teachers and school officials.
4. Students shall conduct themselves in such a manner as to not disrupt the school activity, deprive students of the right to learn, or is forbidden.
5. A student shall not willfully disobey or openly defy a teacher's authority or persistently fail to comply with rules.
6. A student shall not use or display profane or obscene language or gestures.
7. A student shall not knowingly possess, handle, or transmit any object that can reasonably be considered a weapon.
8. A student shall not knowingly possess, use, transmit, or be under the influence of any drugs other than those authorized for the student by prescription from a licensed physician.
9. The student shall not use tobacco in any form on school premises or while attending a school-sponsored activity. The use and/or possession of tobacco by a student under the age of 18 is illegal.
10. Students will be courteous and respectful of hosts, speakers, and other participants.
11. Students will be respectful of buildings, facilities, and grounds and will not enter areas or use any equipment without permission.
