MHS Bands Fall 2023

- 1. **All freshmen** are required to compete with the marching band for one year.
 - All band students are ENCOURAGED to participate with the marching band.
 - b. **ALL enrolled band students** are REQUIRED to participate at all Football games, parades, and concerts during the marching band season.
 - i. Students choosing to <u>not</u> compete with the marching band will play in the stands at all games, march with the band in parades, and perform at concerts.
 - c. In order to earn your MAC High Activity Letter, students must be enrolled in two full years of band and participate for two years with the marching band. (end of Sophomore year). Non-competing students will receive their activity letter at the conclusion of their Senior year after 4 years of band enrollment.
- 2. Students choosing to participate with the marching band:
 - a. This is an intricate, artistic, athletic, and competitive art form.
 - b. YOU have selected to participate; you have selected to commit yourself for the <u>duration of the season</u>. You are the most important person on the field! There is NO 'QUITTING', no missing rehearsals without prior knowledge, all performances are required, learning your music is essential; being a positive, energetic, excited, and fun human being is a must.
 - c. If you are having a bad day, you're exhausted, hungry, frustrated, anxious, depressed, it is raining, 8:30 PM and Mr. Barton yells "one more time!!" Look around... you aren't alone. There are at least 50 other students who understand exactly how you feel. They are glad you are there, they care about you as family; and when the day is finally over, they will give you a hug, a high 5, pat on the back, words of encouragement... and then probably tell you to go grab the yard markers and help clean up.. Welcome to band!
 - d. September stinks: October RULES! And then it is over.
 - e. There is a \$250 fee for marching band this year. **A \$50 non-refundable fee is due by June 1st.** If this is a hardship, please contact Mr. Barton. No student will be denied due to finances.

The marching band competition schedule this fall will look something like this:

Band Camp July 31 - August 4th, 9:00 am - 11:30 am, 1 pm - 4pm, 6 pm - 8:30 pm Mornings on Baker Field, Afternoons inside the school, Evenings in the stadium if possible, otherwise on Baker Field.

Fall marching rehearsals: Every Tuesday and Thursday 6 pm - 8:30 pm August 8th - October 26th, on Baker Field, and Saturdays 9-12 in the stadium or on the half field

Saturday, September 23rd Linfield Tournament of Bands Competition Saturday, October 7th Kamiak Music in Motion Competition (overnight) Saturday, Oct 14th Grants Pass Pride of the Northwest Competition (overnight) Saturday, Oct 28th - Championships at Autzen Stadium Wortman Stadium Parent performance and football games dates TBD

Other performances include middle school and elementary schools during the day.

- All performances are required.
- I will NOT accept "work" as a viable excuse for missing rehearsals or performances.
- Parents: DO NOT USE THE BAND AS PUNISHMENT FOR MISBEHAVIOR AT HOME OR BAD GRADES
- This is NOT a carrot on a stick, this is a competitive activity that everyone depends on everyone else. I'm a parent, I understand.
- Fees need to be paid if you need assistance YOU MUST CONTACT ME!!! Let's chat.
- Students in multiple activities: a performance or competition in any activity is
 more important than a rehearsal or practice in any other activity. If you are
 coming to rehearsal from another activity, you will be given time to rest and eat
 first. PLEASE be smart in bringing food and liquid between activities. Make sure
 both coaches (band director) know the schedules and possible conflicts that exist
 at the BEGINNING of the season.
- Parents: If your student is struggling in any way, please contact me so that we can assist them through their difficulties.
- The student will always be more important than the activity! We must hold students to a high standard with specific expectations and it isn't always easy.

MHS School Event/Activity Student Agreement Code of Conduct

- 8. A student shall not knowingly possess, use, transmit, or be under the influence of any drugs other than those authorized for the student by prescription from a licensed physician.
- 9. The student shall not use tobacco in any form on school premises or while attending a school-sponsored activity. The use and/or possession of tobacco by a student under the age of 18 is illegal.
- 10. Students will be courteous and respectful of hosts, speakers, and other participants.
- 11. Students will be respectful of buildings, facilities, and grounds and will not enter areas or use any equipment without permission.

 - b. Suspension (In-School and/or Out-of-School)
 - c. Expulsion
 - d. Or other actions determined by school administration
